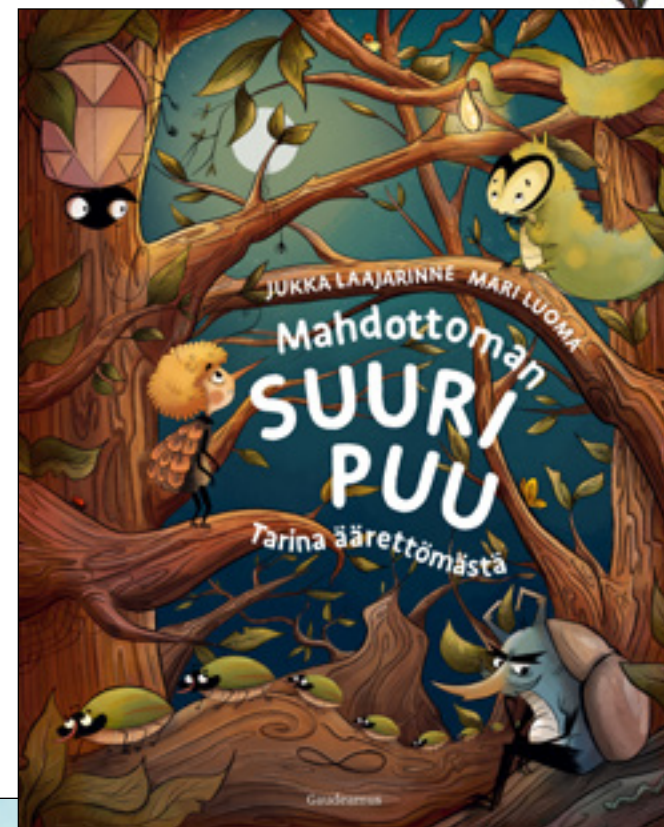
The Impossibly Big Tree weaves together mathematical and philosophical ponderings on infinity into a hilarious adventure.

150 ml Single cream
200g Chocolate (broken into pieces)
